

GLASS OF MILK AMIGURUMI

- Free Crochet Amigurumi Pattern by MJ Carlos -



SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

PATTERN NOTES

- You'll need to know how to make a magic ring/circle.
- You will be crocheting in spirals.
- Invisible decrease technique was used for this pattern - if you're not familiar with this decrease, a regular single crochet decrease is perfectly fine to do.
- Have fun crocheting!

YOU WILL NEED:

- 3.5mm crochet hook
- 8 ply (light worsted/DK) yarn in light blue or light grey and white or cream
- Yarn needle
- 7.5mm safety eyes
- Toy stuffing
- Scissors
- Small amount of pink yarn
- Stitch marker (optional)
- Sewing pins (optional)

ABBREVIATIONS (US Crochet Terms)

Rnd - round

sc - single crochet

dc - double crochet

inc - single crochet increase (2 sc in one stitch)

dec - single crochet decrease (sc 2 together)

BLO - back loops only

st / sts - stitch / stitches

rep - repeat

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GLASS OF MILK

GLASS (Begin in Light Blue or Light Grey yarn)

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in a magic ring (6 sts)

Rnd 2: Inc in each st around (12 sts)

Rnd 3: Sc 1, inc; rep 6 times (18 sts)

Rnd 4: Sc 2, inc; rep 6 times (24 sts)

Rnd 5: Sc 3, inc; rep 6 times (30 sts)

Rnd 6: BLO sc around (30 sts)

Rnd 7: Sc around (30 sts)

Change to White or Cream yarn.

Rnd 8: Sc 14, inc; rep 2 times (32 sts)

Rnd 9: Sc around (32 sts)

Rnd 10: Sc 15, inc; rep 2 times (34 sts)

Rnd 11: Sc around (34 sts)

Rnd 12: Sc 16, inc; rep 2 times (36 sts)

Rnd 13: Sc around (36 sts)

Rnd 14: Sc 17, inc; rep 2 times (38 sts)

Rnd 15: Sc around (38 sts)

Rnd 16: Sc 18, inc; rep 2 times (40 sts)

Rnd 17: Sc around (40 sts)

Rnd 18: Sc 19, inc; rep 2 times (42 sts)

Rnd 19: Sc around (42 sts)

Rnd 20: Sc 20, inc; rep 2 times (44 sts)

Rnd 21: BLO sc around (44 sts)

Attach safety eyes between rounds 11 and 12, 10 stitches apart.

Rnd 22: Sc 9, dec; rep 4 times (40 sts)

Rnd 23: Sc 8, dec; rep 4 times (36 sts)

Rnd 24: Sc 4, dec; rep 6 times (30 sts)

Add toy stuffing. Don't overstuff – add a small amount of stuffing at a time and try to keep the bottom of the glass as flat as possible. Continue to add stuffing until closing.

Rnd 25: Sc 3, dec; rep 6 times (24 sts)

Rnd 26: Sc 2, dec; rep 6 times (18 sts)

Rnd 27: Sc 1, dec; rep 6 times (12 sts)

Rnd 28: Dec 6 times (6)

Fasten off and leave a long tail. Using your yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loops of the remaining stitches and pull to close. Weave in and hide yarn tail.

GLASS RIM (Use Light Blue or Light Grey yarn)

Place a slipknot on your hook. For Round 1, work into the leftover front loops of Round 21 of the glass.

Rnd 1: Sc around (44 sts)

Rnd 2: Sc 21, inc; rep 2 times (46 sts)

Rnd 3: Sc around (46 sts)

Rnd 4: Sc 22, inc; rep 2 times (48 sts)

Rnd 5: Sc around (48 sts)

Fasten off and weave in yarn tail. You can create an invisible fasten off if you wish for a neater finish.

ARM (Use White or Cream yarn, make 2)

Rnd 1: Work 2 sc, 3 dc, 2 sc in a magic ring (7 sts)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

SEWING

- Using white yarn, sew the nose by making 5 horizontal stitches between the eyes.
- Using pink yarn, sew the blush by making 2 horizontal stitches below the eyes.
- Sew the arms on either side of the glass of milk (for placement, sew between rounds 10 and 11, about 3 stitches apart from the eye).
