

CLEMENTINE AMIGURUMI

- Free Crochet Amigurumi Pattern by MJ Carlos -



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SKILL LEVEL: Beginner

PATTERN NOTES

- You'll need to know how to make a magic ring/circle.
- You will be crocheting in spirals.
- The leaf is crocheted around a foundation chain.
- Invisible decrease technique was used for this pattern - if you're not familiar with this decrease, a regular single crochet decrease is perfectly fine to do.
- A chain 1 - picot stitch (slip stitch on the back bump of the chain) is used in this pattern.

YOU WILL NEED:

- 3mm and 2.5mm crochet hook
- 8ply (DK/Light Worsted) yarn in Orange and Green
- Small amount of Pink yarn
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Stitch marker (optional)
- Toy stuffing
- 7.5mm plastic safety eyes (2)

ABBREVIATIONS (US Crochet Terms)

Rnd - round
 ch - chain
 sc - single crochet
 sl st - slip stitch
 hdc - half double crochet
 dc - double crochet
 inc - single crochet increase (2 sc in one stitch)
 dec - single crochet decrease (sc 2 together)
 p - ch1-picot
 st / sts - stitch / stitches
 rep - repeat

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CLEMENTINE (in Orange yarn, use 3mm hook)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6 sts)

Rnd 2: Inc in each st around (12 sts)

Rnd 3: Sc 1, inc; rep 6 times (18 sts)

Rnd 4: Sc 2, inc; rep 6 times (24 sts)

Rnd 5: Sc 3, inc; rep 6 times (30 sts)

Rnd 6: Sc 4, inc; rep 6 times (36 sts)

Rnd 7: Sc 5, inc; rep 6 times (42 sts)

Rnds 8 - 14: Sc around (42 sts)

Attach safety eyes between rounds 12 and 13, 6 stitches apart.

Rnd 15: Sc 5, dec; rep 6 times (36 sts)

Rnd 16: Sc 4, dec; rep 6 times (30 sts)

Rnd 17: Sc 3, dec; rep 6 times (24 sts)

Rnd 18: Sc 2, dec; rep 6 times (18 sts)

Add toy stuffing and continue to add stuffing until closing.

Rnd 19: Sc 1, dec; rep 6 times (12 sts)

Rnd 20: Dec 6 times (6 sts)

Fasten off and leave a long yarn tail. Using a yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each stitch and pull it tight to close. Weave and hide the yarn tail through the piece several times, but do not trim the yarn yet.

LEAF (make 2 in Green yarn, use 2.5mm hook)

Ch 8.

Skip 2 chains, dc 2, hdc, sc 2, sc + p + sc, sc 2, hdc, dc, dc inc. Sl st on top of ch 2. Ch 5. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING AND ASSEMBLY

1. Using the leftover yarn tail, make the nose by sewing 6 horizontal stitches, 3 stitches wide between the eyes.
2. Using pink yarn, make the blush by sewing 2 horizontal stitches, 2 stitches wide, below each eye.
3. Sew the leaves on the top of the clementine.
